PREVENT: Our duty is to prevent learners and staff from being radicalised into extremist views and commit acts of terrorism. Radicalisation: The process by which a person comes to support extremism and terrorism.

Extremism: Vocal or active opposition to core values such as democracy, the rule of law and mutual respect and tolerance of different faiths and beliefs, often involving terrorism.

Terrorism: A violent action against people or property, designed to create fear and advance a political, religious or ideological cause.
